- No travel forms required



- May rent/purchase equipment from outside vendors



- RSO status may not provide appropriate requirements for league affiliation



- Tabling opportunity at Student Org Fair

- Must complete End of the Semester Summaries (2x year)
- Must compete twice per academic year
- Safety Officer Required with (2) members being CPR/AED/First Aid certified
- Utilizes Priority Points System for Funding (practice requests, community service, competition, travel)
- Must keep contact information and RSO Contacts current in WIN

- Assigned a student liaison (1-8 ratio)
- Monthly Council Meetings required
- Monthly Officer Meetings required
- Must complete an orientation session during registration
- Must complete Badgers Step Up! Training

- Travel Requests and approval required for all travel
- Post Event Summary required upon return
- Consent Forms (Waivers) completed annually for all participants

- Able to provide basic equipment
- Discounts with equipment vendors
- Storage space for equipment
- Submit equipment inventory each semester

- Required to be a member of a National Governing Body
- Club status may be required for state, regional, national league affiliation

- Use of Rec Well Logo
- Webpage on Rec Well Website
- Access to Marketing & Social Media
- Provide Participant Verification Letters to Instructors/Professors
- Follow Sport Club Handbook
