

The following charges will be assessed to events that require supervision or additional staffing. The extent of supervision will be determined by University Recreation & Wellbeing and will depend on the nature and scope of the event, applicable safety standards, and/or recommendations as outlined by the American Red Cross Standards and Recommendations, University of Wisconsin-Madison Policies and Procedures, Wisconsin Health Codes, and other standards, recommendations, or guidelines published by related sport or recreation associations or organizations.

Facility Supervisors: Required anytime an event is ongoing at times when the facility is closed or if it is deemed necessary by the Assistant Director of Scheduling & Events to have a certified staff member present to serve as the building manager. Required to be on site for any event hosted at an outdoor activity space managed by University Recreation & Wellbeing.

Event Staff: May be required to provide help with set-up, take down, clean up, or general assistance during an event.

Lifeguards: Required anytime an event takes place in a pool. The number of lifeguards will be determined based upon the number of people and the total pool space that is occupied.

Aquatics Meet Management: Required anytime a swim, dive or water polo competition takes place in the pool.



Wolf Teaching Kitchen and Mt. Mendota Climbing Wall: Staff required for all reservations. The number of staff will be determined based upon the number of people.
